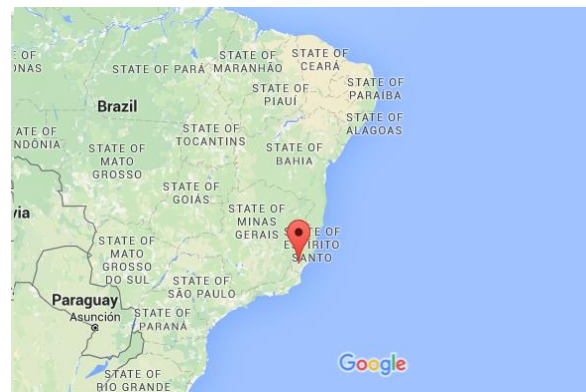

Farms in this region traditionally pass from generation to generation, and the practice continues today. The Nalli family immigrated from Italy in early 1900 and its patriarch raised nine children on the farm. Today it's their children who manage 3 parcels of 10 hectares each: Sertão de Bateia, Sao Gabriel and Sitio Nalli. The property houses 60 family members who collaborate, harvest and participate in many social, cultural, religious, and environmental aspects of the community. Coffee is the main source of income and until recently, the family sold all coffee yields into the local market. The focus on specialty coffee began in 2002 when members learned how to mitigate humidity levels by investing in solar houses, depulpers, wood silos and washing tanks. The washed and pulped natural processing techniques produce 300 bags of sparkling, clean cups. Atlantic Specialty is honored to bring this 2013 COE winner to your family gathering!
