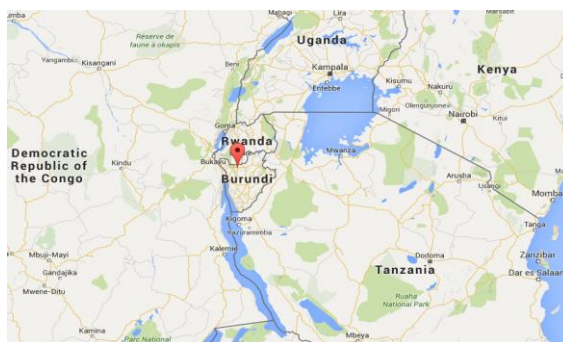

Burundi is a tiny landlocked country that is up and coming in the specialty coffee scene. Tightly-knit cooperatives and well organized washing stations are known for producing complex coffees that rival the best coffees from neighboring countries such as Rwanda and Kenya.

Our lot is produced by 1,350 small holder producers in the community of Nyangwe, within the greater Kayanza growing region of Northern Burundi. Each farmer owns roughly 150 coffee trees, and they use mostly organic methods for growing coffee, although no certification is currently held. Farmers bring their harvested cherry to the Mpanga washing station nearby to be processed. The station pays farmers above-market pricing based on the quality of cherry.

Mpanga washing station has developed an international reputation for producing high quality coffees. In 2014 they placed first at the prestigious Cup of Excellence national competition for quality.
