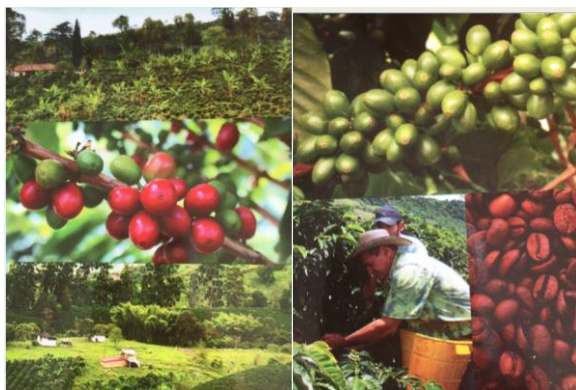

Antioquia



Antioquia, while not a new region for coffee growing, is one of Colombia's emerging specialty coffee regions. This lot was milled at our Buga facility and is sourced for us by our sister office, C.C.A/Condor. It underwent approximately 24 hours of fermentation and was mechanically dried.

This Colombia cultivar is developed from Caturra and Timor hybrid varieties. It is disease resistant, particularly to Roya, and is known for producing a high volume of cherry. This lot is classified as Supremo which indicates that the beans are 17/18 screen size. Flavor characteristics include sweet chocolate, caramel and notes of maraschino cherry.
