The Hacienda can be traced back to the year 1896 in the village of Bonda within the region of Onaca in Santa Marta. Early on, the farm sold their coffee to local merchants in Santa Marta, but the coffee was soon recognized for its excellent flavor and acquired by a foreigner by the name of Kunhard. Mr. Kunhard was in the fruit industry, and as soon as he purchased the farm, he began putting his agricultural expertise to work, expanding the growing region, optimizing yield and purchasing necessary machinery. In the 1930's the farm was handed down to the second generation of the Kunhard family, who decided to sell part of the farm to an association of prominent local Santa Marta families. Later the last of the family's share was sold and the Hacienda is currently 100% owned by the association.

The Organic and Rain Forest Alliance certifications came naturally as the Hacienda has set up preservation practices, making room for ecological diversity while increasing their local ecosystem's sustainability. This lot is packed in Grainpro to preserve freshness.
