Grupo de Asesores de Produccion Organica y Sustentable SC is comprised of 2,197 farms and spans 5,559 hectares devoted primarily to coffee. These farms produce an average yield of 772,000 lbs of coffee per hectare. The coffee area is protected by partial shade and the cooperative carries the following certifications: Organic, Fairtrade, SMBC Bird-Friendly and UTZ.

The farm provides temporary housing for its labor force which has electricity, running water, stove for cooking, and bedding raised off the floor, adhering to the Mexican Federal Labor Laws. Only local labor works the land and no paid workers cross international borders. Coffee pulp is composted on the farm level and parchment is dried on patios rather than mechanical driers.
