Mr. Montenegro is a founding member of the El Palto co-op. He has a 6 hectare farm located in the town of Gracias a Dios within the district of Lonya Grande in the Utcubamba Province. An entrepreneur as well as a driver of new production techniques, Montenegro was the first farmer in the co-op to sell his coffee as a micro-lot and the first to introduce the use of a solar dryer on his farm. El Palto co-op produces certified Organic and Fair Trade coffee and has invested a portion of their premium to renovate their crops and convert their members to organic methods that work to conserve the rainforest.

Through a joint partnership with our friends at Ecotierra, Atlantic Specialty Coffee has offset 6 tons of CO2 emissions related to the transport of select Microlots from El Palto. The <u>verified carbon credits</u> are generated from a forest preservation project developed by Peruvian based Bosques Amazonicos del Peru (BAM) and aims at reducing emissions from deforestation and degradation of virgin rainforest in southeastern Peru.
