Indonesia has a long history cultivating coffee. After Ethiopia and the Arabian Peninsula, Indonesia is the third country where coffee was first grown and produced. Dutch colonists brought coffee seedlings to the island of Java in the late 1600s and cultivation spread to Sumatra, Bali, Sulawesi and Timor by the mid-1800s.

PT. Indo CafCo, Atlantic Specialty's sister office in Sumatra, has been working with farmers in the Aceh region for over a decade making improvements in harvesting techniques and production methods in order to increase cup quality. “Golden Gayo” is a regional blend of coffees produced by small holder farmers in the micro region of Bener Meriah, within the Gayo Highlands of Northern Sumatra. Only coffees grown above 1300 meters above sea level are included in this blend.

“Golden Gayo” is a classic profile Sumatra with notes of leather, fresh tobacco, cocoa, honey and light cherry fruit. This coffee is organic and Rainforest Alliance certified.
